To be held on the 1.2km circuit B short circuit at Morgan Park (clockwise direction), Warwick, Qld

Saturday, 27th & Sunday 28th February 2010

1. Authority

This event is held under the International Sporting Code of the FIA and the National Competition Rules of the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport (CAMS), the Speed Event Standing Regulations, the Passenger In Vehicle guidelines, these Supplementary Regulations and any Further Regulations that may be issued. CAMS Permit Number: **410/2802/01** has been issued, to cover both the 'come and try day' and also the supersprint.

2. Promoter, OH&S and Risk Management Policy

The event will be promoted and organised by the Historic Racing Car Club of Qld Inc., PO Box 353, Red Hill QLD 4059.

This Event will be conducted under and in accordance with CAMS OH&S and Risk Management Policies, which can be found on the CAMS website at www.cams.com.au.

Insurance for this event is provided in accordance with Appendix I of the current CAMS Manual.

4. Entries

Entries for the event open on publication of these supplementary regulations and close on Friday 5th February 2010. Entry fees are set out on page 8.

Entries to:- **Secretary of the Meeting, February Fun, 21 Old Toowoomba Road, Ipswich, Qld 4305.** All Cheques are to be made payable to HRCC Qld (Inc.) and are not considered received until honoured. Cheques will not be deposited until entries close and the entry is accepted. A fee of \$30 will apply to any dishonoured cheque. Entry fees are non-refundable except in accordance with NCR72 whereby a withdrawal of entry must be notified in writing not less than two weeks prior to the event. An administration fee of \$30 will apply to any refund. Entries received without payment are not classed as entries received.

The maximum number of entries that may be limited to 100 for each event and will be determined on order of receipt of paid entries. In accordance with NCR 83 of the current CAMS Manual, the Organising Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry.

5. Eligible Entries

The event is open to competitors who hold a level 2S CAMS licence or a CAMS Licence of higher status. There will also be a CAMS Level 1 Licence available for come and try participants on Saturday for a \$25 cash payment on the day and a CAMS Level 2 Single Event Licence for drivers in the Sunday Sprints for a \$55 cash payment on the day.

6. Eligible Vehicles

Cars participating in the event are required to comply with the relevant NCR's as defined in Section 6, Schedules A and B of the current CAMS Manual, including the following requirements:

- Must be in a roadworthy and presentable condition
- Minimum of a three-point seat belt or approved harness system
- A fire extinguisher securely held by one or more metal restraining straps in a metal bracket securely mounted in the vehicle within easy reach of the driver, which is no older than three years from new or since the most recent inspection or service and which meets AS1 84.
- If fitted with an opening front panel (e.g. bonnet) utilise two separate fastening systems.
- Have all external forward facing glass components (e.g. headlights, fog lights), save for the windscreen, covered by an adhesive film or race tape, which shall effectively inhibit broken glass from being spread over the track.
- Roll-over protection which complies with Schedule J of the NCR's if race tyres are fitted.
- Fuel must be in accordance with Schedule G of the current CAMS Manual.
- Vehicles must be adequately muffled to comply with noise restrictions
- For owners of vehicles that are registered for road use in the state of Queensland your vehicles will be required to have a Third Party Insurance (CTPI) extension certificate.

7. Scrutiny

Scrutiny of vehicles will commence at 7.00am Saturday 27th February for Triple "T" vehicles and from 3.00pm Saturday 27th or from 7.00am Sunday for Sunday Sprints Vehicles. Drivers are reminded to present a current CAMS licence, current CAMS Affiliated club membership card and vehicle Log Book if applicable at Scrutiny. All vehicles must be presented for scrutiny. Level 1 and level 2 single event licence applicants will be required to become an honorary member of the HRCC Qld inc if they are not already a member of a CAMS affiliated car club.

8. Drivers Briefing

There will be a compulsory driver's briefing at 8.30am Saturday 27th February at the Grand Stand for Triple "T" drivers and at 8.00am Sunday at the Grand Stand for Sunday Sprint drivers. All drivers will be required to sign an attendance sheet at the briefing. Additional briefings may be held at the discretion of the clerk of the course. Starting Procedures for the Sunday Sprints will be explained by the Clerk of Course on Sunday.

9. Instructors

Instructors who are over the age of 18 and hold **a current CAMS L2S licence or a CAMS licence of higher status with experience** at the circuit will be eligible to instruct and try participants during the event. The relevant disclaimer must be signed by the participating instructors and have been briefed re "Guidelines for passengers in vehicles."

10. Driver and Instructor Apparel Requirements

To participate in the event drivers AND passengers must wear:

- A helmet to a standard listed in the current CAMS Manual;
- In open cars, goggles or visors other than glass, to AS 1609/1981;
- Clothing that will protect the skin from flame. Non flammable clothing which provides cover from ankles to wrist to throat must be worn. No person will be permitted to wear apparel of nylon or synthetic material. Helmets and driving apparel will be approved at scrutiny in accordance with the requirements of Schedule D of the current CAMS Manual.

11. Conduct of the Event

The components involved in the Triple "T" event are outlined below:

Gates open 6:30am –Scrutiny of vehicles - Meeting of all track officials and trainees — Compulsory Drivers Briefing — Testing session — Introduction to Racing Workshop— Training session with Instructors Break for Lunch — Testing session — Training session with Instructors — Testing session if time permits — 4:00pm Social get together at end of day.

Note Time and locations of sessions, workshops etc will be supplied in Further Supplementary Regulations with acceptance of entry.

Vehicles for the Sunday Sprints will run in order of allocated number in Groups to be determined once entries have been accepted. Double entries will be accepted provided a separate entry is completed for each driver. Drivers will be issued with a number for the Sunday Sprints and these will be supplied by the organisers. Numbers are to be positioned at the top left corner of the windscreen for vehicles with Windscreens. Vehicles without windscreens must affix their number in a forward facing position on the left hand front of the vehicle. The number must be clearly visible to the timekeepers.

12. Timing

Timing for the Sunday Sprints will be by AMB Electronic Timing. A Transponder and Bracket (if required) will be supplied for each driver. A \$100 **Cash** deposit will be required by all drivers when collecting their AMB Electronic Timing Transponders. This deposit will be refunded when the Transponder is returned at the end of the day.

13. Classes for Sunday Sprints

Drivers will be placed into Groups once entries have been accepted and will be notified in the further regulations.

14. Penalties, Reruns and Protests.

The competition surface of the track is defined by the white line and or the back edge of both the apex kerb and the exit kerb. Any competitor who drives beyond this area will be penalised. Tyre frying of any sort will result in immediate disqualification from the event. Reruns will only be allowed when the official timing gear fails or the track is blocked by a spinning or broken down car. All reruns will be at the discretion of the clerk of course. Reruns will not be granted to drivers who spin or cause another car to slow down. Reruns will not be granted for any other reason. Protests must be lodged in accordance with Part XII of the Current CAMS manual.

15. Alcohol/Drugs

During any competition, consumption of alcoholic beverages in the paddock, pits or any other portion of the competition venue under the control of the officials is expressly forbidden until all practice or competition activity is concluded for each day. Any driver or crew member who is found to be affected by alcohol on the day of the event or practice therefore shall not be permitted to participate. Refer NCR 145A of the Current CAMS Manual.

In addition, the persons concerned will be subject to the Articles of the Procedure for Alcohol Testing and CAMS Drugs in Sport Policy. Competitors, crews or officials may be tested for alcohol or other drugs at any time during the event(s). This regulation serves as the required 24-hour notice to Competitors, Crew and Officials.

16. Cancellation

Event Organisers reserve the right to postpone, abandon or cancel the event in accordance with NCR 59 of the current CAMS Manual.

17. General

It is a condition of entry that competitors agree to pay all costs incurred for the use of fire fighting equipment on their cars.

Garage/Shed Hire: Contact Bill Campbell from Warwick and District Car Club 07 46614414 after 8:00pm to arrange for hire of garage/shed or other Morgan park related items. Power is available for non-shed areas for a nominal charge. Overnight camping is allowed for a nominal charge.

The entry fees for the Triple "T" are \$80-00 per vehicle for each primary nominate driver and \$35-00 each for each additional nominated trainee driver (maximum 2 nominated trainee drivers per vehicle). The entry fee for the Sunday Sprints is \$100-00 for each entry (maximum separate 2 drivers per vehicle).
