Dear HRCC Member, Family, Friends and Pit Crews,

The Historic Racing Car Club (Qld) Inc invites you all to join us for a February Fun Weekend including our Annual Triple "T" Training, Testing and Trying day on Saturday 27th and new Sunday Sprints to be held on Sunday 28th February 2010.

The Saturday Triple "T" event is open to all HRCC members and any new trainee drivers who wish to try and experience a taste of Historic Motor Racing for the first time. Testing for cars will also be included on Saturday for those drivers wishing to test their cars at the beginning of the new racing year. The Sunday Sprints is a new HRCC Event and will be held on the Short Front Track at Morgan Park. The Sunday Sprints will be a friendly competitive day with approximately 6 cars on the track in each group. Groups will be decided once entries have been received and posted with the further regulations. Vehicles will be allowed to be double entered with two drivers provided a separate entry form is completed for each driver. The further supplementary regulations will also include the format and location for the training, trying and testing sessions for the Triple "T" event Saturday.

HRCC Members, their Family Members, Friends or Pit Crew can also be trained as officials in several disciplines. Application forms will be available on both days. Also please complete the relevant information on page 7 as required.

Eligible vehicles include 5th Category Historic Cars, pre war and pre 60's Sports and Racing Cars and other invited cars. All vehicles must pass CAMS scrutiny requirements before being allowed to compete.

Trainee Drivers will be eligible to compete in both the Triple "T" and Sunday Sprints events provided they attend the training workshops and Trainee Driving Sessions on Saturday. All Trainee Drivers will be required to obtain a CAMS Level 1 day licence on Saturday and CAMS Level 2 Single Event Licence for Sunday. All drivers, instructors and competitors must be a member of a CAMS affiliated Car Club. Honorary HRCC memberships will be available on both days for those who require it.

Targeted Scrutiny will be available both days for Log Booked cars that need to be brought up to date. Please contact Peter Herlihen on 0414 474 408 to arrange a suitable time. A nominal charge will apply to those requiring this service.

Morgan Park Raceway is situated approximately 2 hours from Brisbane and has plenty of accommodation options for those competitors entering both the Saturday and Sunday events. The short front track is a nice change for competitors. The Morgan Park Raceway canteen will NOT be open on the Saturday but a friendly BBQ lunch will be held for all drivers and officials. The canteen will be open Sunday for breakfast and lunch and any other food and refreshments competitors and spectators may want during the day.

The Supplementary Regulations and Entry forms for this event are attached and can also be accessed from the HRCC website www.hrcc.org.au. Entries are encouraged for either the Triple "T" day or Sunday Sprints or both. A \$10 discount is applicable to those entering both events. If you have any enquires regarding your car's suitability please contact us. I encourage all previous entrants and other competitors who have yet to experience the thrills of Historic Racing to step up and enjoy "The Sport of Motor Racing History" from a different perspective.
