The following is a outline as to what is proposed at the above non-competitive event. The exact program will not be able to be finalised until after all the entries have been received and the number of different categories of vehicles and people can be quantified. A copy of the final program will be available on the day (PLEASE NOTE THE APPROXIMATE TIMES AND THE DATE).

7:00am - Gates Open

8:00am - 10:30am - Scrutineering (*1)

10:00am - Introduction to Racing Workshop (compulsory for all Level 1 Licence holders) (*2)

10:30am - Scrutineering Workshop (open to everyone in the drivers briefing room)

11:00am - Eligibility Workshop (open to everyone in the drivers briefing room)

11:45am - Drivers Briefing (compulsory for every driver - at the Scrutineering Area)

12:30pm - Walking the Track (open to every driver - **meet at Tower at 12:00 noon**)

1:00pm - Testing (Level 2, 3 and 4 licence holders only - see your posted groups) (*3)

2:15pm - Level 1 licence holder events only (see your posted groups) (*4)

3:15pm - Testing (Level 2, 3 and 4 licence holders only - see your posted groups) (*3)

4:30pm - Level 1 licence holder events only (see your posted groups) (*4)

5:30pm - Testing (Level 2, 3 and 4 licence holders only - see your posted groups) (*3)

6:30pm - End of day social get together - all welcome - location to be advised

Notes:-

Please note that due to the extreme high cost of hiring the track it has been hired for a half-day and therefore actual track time does not start till lunch time. Accordingly, it will be extremely important that the track be fully utilised - **please make sure all drivers line up in the dummy grid area while the previous group is still running on the track**

Subject to applicable drivers, each entered vehicle would have at least 4 opportunities to run during the afternoon (two testing runs and two training runs).

All **non-members** of the HRCC who wish to drive a car during the day must have an applicable CAMS licence (Level 1 licences will be available on the day) and they will be made an honorary HRCC member for the day.

(*1) All vehicles using the track will be scrutineered for safety (including any instructor_s seat, seat belts etc). Those interested in knowing more will have the opportunity to attend the Scrutineering Workshop in the morning.

(*2) The Introduction to Racing Workshop is compulsory for all Level 1 licence holders for the day and is optional for anyone else wanting to attend. It will include subjects such as safety, track etiquette, driving techniques, knowing the track, track officials, car preparation etc. and will be held in the drivers briefing room

(*3) The Testing part of the day is only open to Level 2 and above CAMS licence holders and all drivers are reminded that it is **not a competitive event** and safety must come first. Open wheelers will have the track to themselves. Group lists will be posted on the day and each testing Group will have at least two 20 minute sessions on the day

(*4) Level 1 licence holder (one day CAMS licences) events will be carried out as follows:

- it is strongly recommended that all two seater vehicles have a Level 2 or above experienced person alongside (in drivers or passengers seat)
- only one Level 1 licence holder can be in the car at any one time
- no passing will be allowed at any time
- a pace car will be used on your first run of the day
- each Group will have two 15 minute sessions on the day
