INVITATION and Information **HRCC's TTT & Sprints Weekend 23rd & 24th February 2019**

Dear Member/ Competitor,

You are invited to enter HRCC's TTT & Sprint Weekend meeting, to be held on the 23rd & 24th February 2019 at Morgan Park Raceway, WARWICK Queensland. For those who are new to CAMS Events, we recommend that you attend the CAMS Motorsport Expo, February 17th 2019 at the Beenleigh Showgrounds where you can be walked through what you need to know.

This will be a great way to start the new year's racing calendar, with a low keyed friendly weekend of motor events and catching up with old friends and creating new friendships. All types of cars are welcomed to the event, with a maximum of 120 cars for Saturday and 120 for Sunday Sprints. So, get your entry in early to secure a place.

You can enter just Saturday (TTT) or just Sunday (Super Sprint), OR BOTH.

When entering, YOU MUST SELECT Activity 1 (Saturday TTT) or Activity 2 (Sunday Sprint) or Activity 3 (BOTH DAYS).

Saturday TTT (TRY, TRAIN, TEST): starts with a compulsory 8:15am driver briefing

6 x Groups having 4 sessions of approximately 15minutes.

Refreshments with officials at 4.50pm at Canteen.

Options for groups are;

Testing/Practice (Open Wheelers, Sports Cars, Big Tin Tops & Little Tin Tops)

Training Experienced (2 people in car, both must have CAMS licence)

Training New

Notes: Canteen will be open for Saturday lunch

Canteen Open on Sunday morning for breakfast and Lunch

No Practice on Friday before the event

Carport hire: Through the CAMS Online Event Entry

Camping available.

Scrutineering and Sign-on will commence Saturday from 6:45am

Transponders for Sunday Sprints available from tower from 4.00pm Saturday

Engine sealing available Saturday only, especially Groups N & S

Sunday SUPER SPRINTS: starts with compulsory driver briefing 8.15 am

It is envisaged there will be 11 Groups of 10 cars scheduled but numbers will determine the final groupings.

Sign-on & Scrutineering from 7.00am Sunday

Drivers briefing at 8.15am and 1st group on track at its completion

Will continue running groups throughout day and look at finishing by 3.30pm

Groups for Saturday and Sunday will be posted on Club Website (www.hrcc.org.au/events) with Further Supplementary Regulations prior to the event. Always refer to Further Supplementary Regulations for event.

ENTRY TO BE by the online CAMSEventEntry (CEE) System (see over page), which has been adopted by CAMS nationally as an efficient, user friendly event management system.

If you have not entered by CEE (formerly MEE) before, go to www.CAMS.com.au, on the top right hand corner of the Home page you'll see Member Portal. Follow the prompts and be sure to watch the short video to make entering many events nationwide quick and easy. *If you have previously used MotorEventEntry or CEE we ask you to please continue to use the system as this will make entering future events easier and cheaper for YOU.*

The Supplementary Regulations are attached and should be reviewed prior to entering this Event.

TO ENTER: go to www.hrcc.org.au Events and follow the prompts, or login to www.cams.com.au member portal.

Entries will close 15th February 2019 or once all places have been allocated for the event.

MyLaps is the timing system for Sunday Sprints. You will be issued with **car numbers when hiring transponder. A \$100 deposit** is required for all **MyLaps** transponders (unless you have one & supply the serial number with your entry). Deposit is refundable on return of Transponder.

Carport hire: Through the CAMS Online Event Entry along with your entry.

In preparation for the TRY, TRAIN and TEST DAY (TTT) and SPRINT MEETING, FEBRUARY 23-24

Experienced Competitors are also welcome to refresh their knowledge of the current Regulations and expectations, and anyone who has an active interest is most welcome.

This event is designed to give the basic information to enable a competitor to obtain a Level 2 Speed (L2S) Licence, prepare a roadworthy road car for Speed Events (Sprints, Hill Climbs, Regularity Trials), understand the Rules and Controls applying to Competitors and Drivers, and how to Enter the Event. It includes many helpful hints and an insight into what to expect (and what is expected of you) on track.

General Requirements for Drivers,

Registration (paper work) and what to do with it at the track,

Competition cars will be available for you to inspect to illustrate the preparation needed and recommended, and several CAMS Officials will discuss the above subjects and assist with queries.
