The meeting shall be a National Historic Race Meeting held under the FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices, the National Competition Rules of the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport Ltd. (CAMS), The Race Meeting Standing Regulations, the Regularity Trial Standing Regulations, the Speed Event Standing Regulations, the Regulations for 5<sup>th</sup> Category Historic Cars, these Supplementary Regulations and any Further Supplementary Regulations and / or instructions issued for the Meeting.

**Vehicle Requirements:** All vehicles must comply with **Schedules A and B** and Schedule C (for race vehicles) and 5<sup>th</sup> Category – Historic Cars Vehicle Eligibility of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.

### 5. ENTRIES / FEES

## 6. ENTRIES | DETAILS

- a. Entries open on publication of these Regulations and close on **Wednesday 26<sup>th</sup> June 2019**. Entry Fees are **\$390** per entry. Entries received without the correct Entry Fee will NOT be included in the acceptance process. **PLEASE NOTE:** As CAMS Motor Event Entry is used to administer this Event, entrants are asked to lodge entries on - **www.cams.com.au** and use the **Member Portal**
- b. Each entrant will receive 4 entry passes and 1 tender vehicle pass. **NOTE:** These passes will be available for collection from the Pit Entry Gate on arrival. Further weekend passes may be purchased with the Entry when it is lodged for a fee of \$10 each. Entrants need to register a tender vehicle with their entry, and this is the only other vehicle allowed into the Paddock Area during the Event.
- c. CAMS Motor Event Entry or paper Entry Forms must be completed in full, accompanied by the correct payment and lodged prior to the close off date. The maximum number of entries is 300. The Organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry, in accordance with NCR 83. **PLEASE NOTE MAILING ADDRESS** for **paper entry forms** and **payments** is as follows; **HISTORIC QUEENSLAND / PO Box 877 / Mudgeeraba QLD 4213 and must be received by the close of entries.**
- d. All cheques (no cash through the mail, please) are to be made payable to the **Historic Racing Car Club (Qld) Inc.** and are not considered received until honoured. A fee of \$50.00 will apply for a dishonoured cheque. Entry Fees are non-refundable, except in accordance with the provisions of NCR 72 (less an administration fee of \$30.00).
- e. Notification of withdrawal should be verbal with written confirmation / prior to 14 days before Event - **Full Refund** / 13 days to 5 days (Monday 9pm) before Event- **Refund Entry Fee less \$30 Admin Fee** / within 4 days of start of Event- **Entrant to send written request with reasons for consideration** by Committee for Refund less \$30 Admin Fee.
- f. All COMPETITORS in all CLASSES including **Regularity and Super Sprint** are reminded that all HISTORIC CARS must comply with the provisions of **Schedule K (Markings on Automobiles) and Articles 1.3 and 1.4 of General Requirements of the 5<sup>th</sup> Category regulations** regarding advertising and competition numbers under the General Requirements in the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.
  - Regularity and Super Sprint Entrant's cars **must represent the era** of competition.

## 7. EVENTS

- a. It is proposed that over the two days of the Event, all cars will have one qualifying Event plus four (4) Races, of which at least three (3) will be scratch races.
- b. It is proposed that over the two days of the Event, Regularity entrants will have one practice Event plus four (4) Trials.
- c. It is proposed that over the two days of the Event, Super Sprint entrants will have one practice Event plus four (4) Sprints.
- d. **The Event program will be advised in Further Regulations.**

## 8. AWARDS

- a. Awards will be in the form of Trophies and / or Prizes. Awards may be presented to First, Second and Third place getters for the **Lloyd Bax Handicap**, the **Queensland Tourist Trophy**, the **HRCC Trophy** and Groups Overall.
- b. Individual Feature Trophy awards may be presented in the relevant heats as follows;  
The **Chas Whatmore Trophy** (1st Place Only - Group J or K), the **Lionel Ayers Trophy** (1st Place Only - Group O Sports), the **Glenn Seton Trophy** (1st Place Only - Group A), the **John French Trophy** (1<sup>st</sup> Place Only - Group C)
- c. Overall Group winners will be determined by the accumulation of points over all heat races for the relevant group. Points to be allocated as follows: First 30, Second 25, Third 22, Fourth 20, Fifth 19, Sixth 18 Etc...
- d. Awards will be awarded on the basis of number of starters for each group in the following manner:  
1st, 2nd, 3rd for Five (5) or more starters / 1st, 2nd for Four (4) starters / 1st, Three (3) or less starters.

## 9. SCRUTINY | PRACTICE

- a. Targeted Scrutiny will be in operation at this Event and vehicles that are part of this program are required to bring evidence of such to Document Check in the form of a documented log-book. Vehicles which are yet to have their initial targeted scrutiny audit will be required to undergo initial scrutiny.
- b. Scrutiny will take place at the Circuit on Friday, 12 July 2019, between 10.00am and 4.00pm and on Saturday, 13 July 2019, from 7am. Log books and Certificates of Description (where required) must be presented at the Scrutiny Bay. On Sunday, 14 July 2019, a minimum of a safety check may take place.

- c. Timed Qualifying / Practice will take place on Saturday only, and will be the qualifying basis for determining grid positions for the first race. Grid positions for subsequent races will be determined by the finishing order of the preceding race (with non-finishers and non-starters being added at the rear of the field at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course). Where grids are combined for subsequent races, qualifying times will determine the new grid. The Organisers reserve the right to vary, combine, or add to practice sessions, subject to the approval of the Stewards.
- d. Each nominated Driver (including Regularity and Super Sprint entrants) must complete a minimum three (3) timed laps of practice. Drivers that fail to complete a qualifying session may be included on the grid at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course in accordance with CAMS Race Meeting Standing Regulation 5.2.
- e. Competitor Instructions and intended Schedule of Events will be issued with the Further Regulations for the Event.

## 10. LICENCES (INCLUDING INTERNATIONAL DRIVERS)

- a. **Racing Drivers** must hold a minimum of a current CAMS Provisional Clubman Circuit (PCC) Licence except for the following:
  - **A minimum of a National Circuit (NC) Licence and a HPL Endorsement is required for the following high performance 5th Category Historic vehicles:**
    - i. FIA Formula One and Indy Cars (all)
    - ii. F5000 (all)

NOTE: International C/CH licence holders still require the HPL endorsement to compete nationally in the above categories.

  - A National Circuit licence is the minimum requirement for the following 5th Category Historic vehicle Groups:
    - iii. Groups Q and R FIA 2L Formula Two (2000cc)
    - iv. Group R Formula 3000/Formula Holden (all)
    - v. Groups Q and R Sports over 2 Litre engine capacity
    - vi. FIA prototypes Group C1 and C2 Sports (all)
- b. **Regularity and Super Sprint Drivers** must hold a minimum of a current CAMS Speed (Level 2S) Competition Licence.
- c. **All Drivers** must have proof of current membership of a CAMS affiliated Club which must be presented at Scrutiny.
- d. **No licences will be available for issue at the Circuit.**
- e. All Licences, CAMS pass books, competition records, log books, COD's and membership cards must be presented at Scrutiny and also be available if required for inspection at any other time during the course of the Event.

Each Competitor must hold a CAMS Competition Licence as listed above unless they comply with (a) or (b) below.

(i) hold a **Motor Sport New Zealand** competition licence and Tasman Visa valid for the event; or

(ii) **hold a minimum of the highest grade National Licence issued by a foreign ASN together with an authorisation issued by that ASN for the event;** each such Driver and Competitor:

(A) shall be ineligible to score points in any Championship/Cup/Series/Trophy/etc. connected with the event; and

(B) must receive an authorisation to compete from CAMS prior to the event;

The Organiser confirms that the Circuit to be used for this event holds the necessary CAMS National Track licence for each of the events nominated in these Supplementary Regulations.

## 11. DRIVERS BRIEFING

Saturday July 13 2019 at 8:00am at the pit lane grand stand.

## 12. CHANGE OF DRIVER

A change of Driver may be permitted subject to NCR 143. **See the Secretary of the Meeting if a Driver change is required.**

## 13. NOISE EMISSION

All competing vehicles must be fitted with an effective muffler and are **not to exceed** a noise level of **95dB (a)** on the standard 30 metre run-by test.

## 14. CHANGE OF PROGRAMME

The Organisers reserve the right to vary the programme of Events under Race Meeting Standing Regulation 2.4, in the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport, and under NCR 169 (xvi).

## 15. JUDGES OF FACT

- a. The Judges of Fact in respect of the start / finish and noise emission shall be the Clerk of the Course, Deputy and Assistant Clerks of the Course, Secretary of the Meeting, the Chief Timekeeper, the Chief Scrutineer, the Starter and Assistant Starters.
- b. Judge of Fact for speed in the Pit Lane or driving over kerbs will be notified by Bulletin.

## 16. FIRE EXTINGUISHERS

Competitors will be required to pay for the servicing of any fire extinguishers used on their vehicle.

## 17. ABANDONMENT, POSTPONEMENT & CANCELLATION

The Organisers reserve the right to abandon, postpone or cancel the meeting at their sole discretion subject to NCR 59.

## 18. TIMING

- a. The "My Laps" electronic timing system will be used.
- b. All Competitors not owning their own MyLaps X2 transponder will be supplied with a timing transponder at no charge. A \$100 cash deposit will be required for the transponder; this will be refunded upon safe return of the transponder at the end of the Meeting.
- c. Times will be posted on the bottom floor of the Pit Lane Tower and will also be uploaded to My Laps website after each Round.
- d. Timing transponders, for those requiring them, will be available on Friday, 12 July 2019, from 1:30pm at Document Check, or from the timing room on the 1<sup>st</sup> floor of the Pit Lane Tower from 7:00am. Saturday, 13 July 2019.

## 19. FUEL

Fuel must comply with Schedule G of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport. Group A & C competitors participating in the Heritage Touring Car event should refer to the Heritage Touring Car Sporting Regulations.

**NOTE: NO LEADED FUELS ARE PERMITTED AT THIS MEETING.**

## 20. CTP. INSURANCE EXTENSION

**PLEASE NOTE: Vehicles road registered in Queensland** under the "Transport Operations (Road Use Management / Vehicle Registration) Regulation 1999" require a Compulsory Third Party Insurance (CTP) extension valid for this meeting.

## 21. INSURANCE

## 22. PROTESTS

Any protests must be lodged in accordance with Part XII of the current CAMS National Competition Rules (NCR's).

## 23. GENERAL

### a. Alcohol, Drugs and Other Substances

Any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of drugs (or other banned substances) and subject to a penalty(ies) for a breach in accordance with the CAMS Anti-Doping Policy and/or the CAMS Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy as published on the CAMS website.

Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any section of the competition venue/course under the control of the Officials is forbidden until all competition is concluded each day. Accordingly, any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may also be tested for the presence of alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the CAMS Standard Operating Procedure for Breath Alcohol Testing.

- ### b. This Event will be conducted under and in accordance with CAMS OH&S, CAMS Safety 1st and Risk Management Policies, which can be found on the CAMS website at [www.cams.com.au](http://www.cams.com.au)
- ### c. Pit lane speed limit shall be 40 kph.

## 24. PIT | PADDOCK

- ### a. The Pit/ Paddock area at Morgan Park is limited, with control and your co-operation we can accommodate Race Cars, Tender Vehicles, with limited area for Transporters, Motor homes and Camping within the confines of the Paddock Area. **Only one tender vehicle (with tender vehicle pass clearly displayed) per entrant will be allowed into the Paddock Area during the Event.**
- ### b. PIT / PADDOCK Marshals will be available to assist with all below.
- ### c. ALL TRAILERS should be parked in the "Trailer Park" on the left hand side of the entry road to the Paddock Area ONLY.
- ### d. **ENTRY to Paddock Area for Interstate Competitors is after 1.00pm Thursday 11 July 2019** and all Competitors after 7.00am Friday 12 July 2019. NOTE: Gates are closed at 6.00pm each of these days, WDSCC Requirement.
- ### e. The Paddock Area will be laid out with WORKING BAYS 4.0 to 5.0m wide x 7.0m to 12.0m deep, **if you need more space see contact below.**
- ### f. POWER SITES are available, located near the 8 Power Poles behind (Eastern Side of) the Lower Level Carports. NO RESERVATIONS are possible. OH&S restricts the use of power leads on the ground and NO double adaptors may be used.
- ### g. CAMPING is allowed for Competitors along the East side fence and North end of the Main Pit Area, but note that there is no power close to these areas. Cost of camping is NIL.
- ### h. PANTEC'S / Over 9.0m rigs please advise, as per item J. below, of your attendance at least 2 weeks in advance; see contact below, advise number of Race Cars, Competitors names and area required. NO RESERVATIONS. We will ONLY make allowance for the number of Pantecs / Transporters we are advised of. Please See Contact below
- ### i. CARPORT hire costs \$110.00, these must be BOOKED and PAID with your entry as there is a limited number available. Carports will be allocated according to Race car needs, e.g. Low racing cars - low sports/racing cars - slick tyres - interstate race Competitors. Carports are 3.6 x 6.0m with power every 4th bay. The tender vehicle parking will be as directed. **NOTE: Carports will be allocated on a First- in, First- served basis.**
